You can decide from log cabins, summer camps, chalets, bed and breakfasts and lake front cottages with lake rights that are all available to rent on a weekly or less than weekly basis. Adirondack rentals are meant to enjoy all year round, not just summertime. If autumn is your favorite season, come on up and enjoy the fall colors from the front porch of an Adirondack rental. And wintertime, well, it goes without saying that there is plenty to do in the Adirondacks in the winter. You could spoil yourself with a condominium in one of the many area ski resorts.
