Are the shops certified by the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE), and do they employ ASE certified master technicians?

Once you have settled on a car repair shop, make sure the technician gives you a written repair estimate, so you know exactly what to expect. And, if you like the work, take your car back to that same shop for all your car repair work; establishing a regular relationship with a good repair shop will pay you dividends in the long run.
