

Brief Overview Of Rochester NY

Rochester is a city located in Monroe, New York. The city is one of the metropolitan cities of the United States and advanced infrastructure and facilities are available over there. Rochester NY is a city full of cultural values and traditions. There are a number of culture institutions in Rochester NY like Gath Fagan Dance, George Eastman House International, Memorial Art Gallery, Rochester Museum & Science Center and various other art organizations.

Interestingly, Geva Theater Center is the largest professional theater of Rochester NY. One of the major attractions of Rochester NY is its nightlife. In the Southeast, the East End District has a number of nightspots. Rochester NY is also known as The Flower City and Lilac Festival is arranged every year in the city. Lilac festivals are organized every year in May in Rochester NY. About 400 varieties of Lilac are presented in the festival and near about 10,000 people come on the festival.

Although Rochester NY is a metropolitan city, still there is historical architecture and artwork promoted in the city. The major cultural of the city is represented by Genesee Country Village and Museum. This village preserves the local architecture, model gardens, and sporting and carriage museums. In addition to the preservation of the cultural values, festivals are also organized in the city. Some of the famous festivals celebrated in Rochester NY are Jazz Festival, Com Hill Festival, Clothesline art festivals, Lilac Festival and many others. The Rochester NY accent is a form of Inland Northern American English. This accent is very similar to Chicago or Detroit accent. As 55% of the population of Rochester comprise of blacks therefore, the accent of the native Rochesterians has been changed.
